

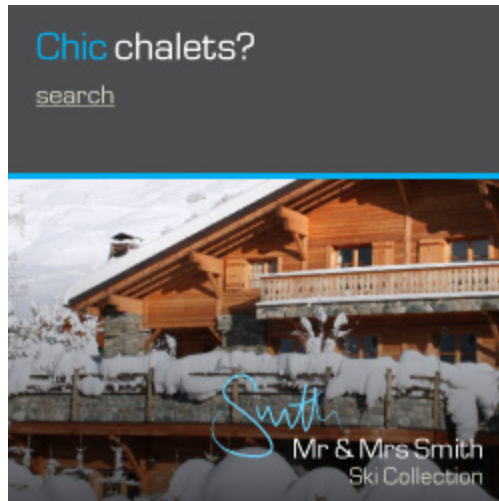

“At especially tough economic times like this, we need to remind ourselves on how crucial the elements of philanthropy are in our community.

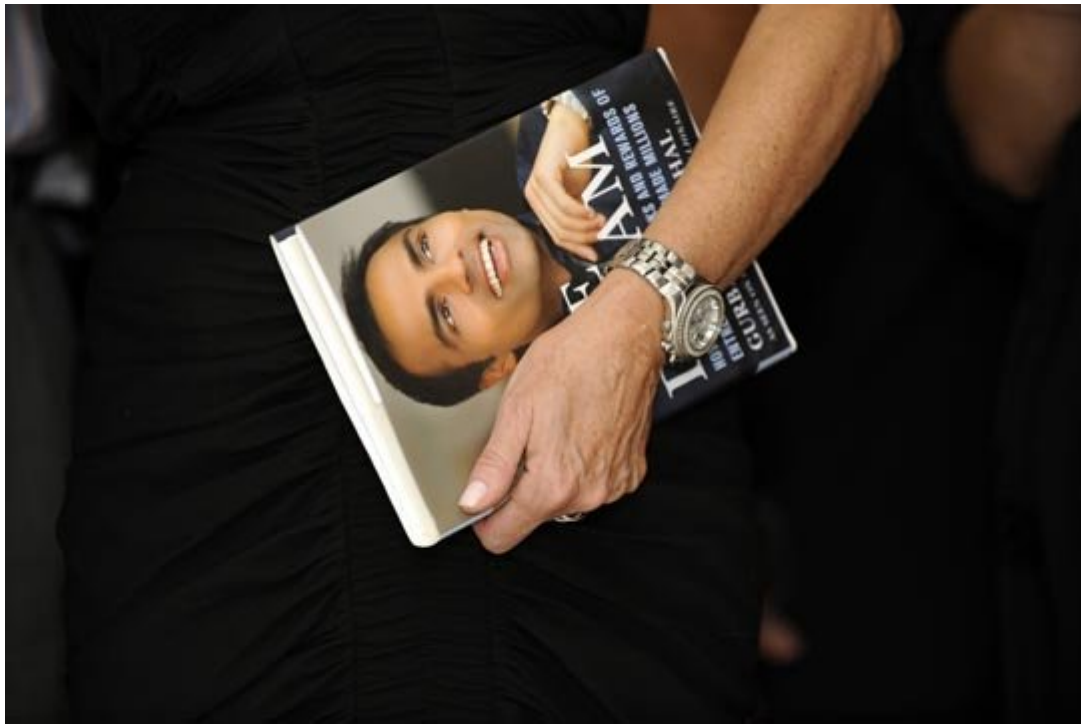
“Having a show that inspires this message every week — will allow the Bay Area community — to realize sometimes the best gift in life is to give.

“I fully support what Sophie is trying to achieve,” added ‘G’.

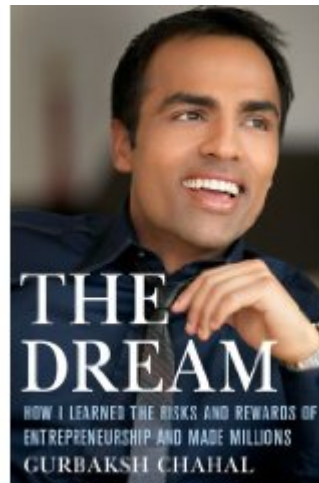
